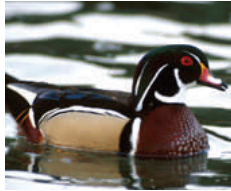




### Wood Duck Nest Box

- Hole size: 4" x 3"
- Size: 11"Wx14"Dx29"H
- Inside dimensions: 9"Wx9.25"Dx22.5"H
- Weight: 12 lbs
- Placement: wood swamps, bottomland, above or near water



### Bluebird

Bluebirds were once common across Ohio when the countryside was composed of a mixture of small fields of hay, oats, corn, pastures, and orchards. As farming changed to a more monoculture approach -- extensive fields of corn and soybeans -- away from pastures and orchards, bluebird habitat declined in Ohio. Additionally, the introduction of the European starling and house sparrow increased competition for the few nesting cavities available. Both factors have contributed to a decline in bluebirds in the state.

### Wren

The Wren family is a group of small, restless, brownish birds with finely barred wings and tails. Wrens have long, slender bills which are slightly decurved. The best field mark is the way the tail is usually cocked straight-up. Their favorite food is insects.

### Wood Duck - Puddle Duck

Puddle ducks are typically birds of fresh, shallow marshes and rivers rather than of large lakes and bays. They are good divers, but usually feed by dabbling or tipping rather than by submerging. Any duck feeding in croplands will likely be a puddle duck, for most of this group are surefooted and can walk and run well on land. Their diet consists of mostly vegetables.

The wood duck is the most numerous breeding duck in Ohio and second only to the mallard in terms of harvest in Ohio. It is found in all flyways, but is most numerous in the Atlantic and Mississippi Flyways. They are early migrants; most of them have left the northern states by mid-November.

### Big Brown Bat

There are many things that distinguish bats in the animal world. Bats are the only mammals capable of flight. For mammals, they are an evolutionarily old group with fossil records dating back 50 million years.

The big brown bat is one of 13 bat species recorded in Ohio. It is likely the second most abundant species of bat in the state (the little brown bat is thought to be the most abundant species in the state). It will readily use man-made structures for hibernation, as well as for maternity colonies.
