

Hand Planting Bars

Purpose:

The Purpose of providing the hand planting bars is to promote reforestation in marginal lands and to promote Christmas tree production in Muskingum County.

Policy:

The following policy has been adopted by the Muskingum Soil and Water Conservation District Board of Supervisors to effectively carry out this program.

There is no charge for using these planting bars. A deposit is required when the agreement is signed for the use of the planting bars. The deposit of \$45.00 is refunded in full to the user upon the return of the undamaged planting bar.

The user will be limited to three consecutive calendar days before the planting bar **must be returned**.

If the planting bar is not returned by the user after three consecutive calendar days, the penalty shall be forfeiture of the total deposit.

The planting bar will be picked up and returned by the user during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the District office.

The user will be responsible for damages to the planting bar due to misuse or negligence. The payment for such damages shall be forfeiture of the total deposit.

The planting bars can only be used within the boundaries of Muskingum Sounty, or on District cooperater property adjacent to Muskingum County.

The planting bars will be made available to landowners on a first-come, firs serve basis without regard to race, religion, color, sex, or national origin.
