#### **Muskingum SWCD Supervisor Candidate Announcement**

A Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor represents county residents in soil and water conservation and natural resources management. Supervisors set the District's policy, provide guidance to staff, and assist on projects. The Board consists of five supervisors who serve for three-year terms on a voluntary basis. Supervisors participate in monthly and special board meetings, and attend area and state meetings. This year, candidates will be nominated to fill one open position. Potential candidates are expected to have experience relevant to the District's goals. The qualities of a potential supervisor include:

- Widespread knowledge of natural resources in the county
- Complement the existing make-up of the district board so that all geographic, educational, and landuse interests within the district are represented
- Leadership ability and willingness to share time and talent.

The Nominating Committee will present a slate of candidates. Qualified residents, 18 years of age or older, may also petition to be on the ballot. Information from your own field is always better than from somewhere else! We are looking for 20 producers or fields to make at least a 2-year commitment to do something different on your operation. You will receive the information, soil tests and a small stiperd for your participation. Some of the possibilities for the challenge are cover crop versus no cover crop, single species cover crop versus multi-species cover crop, different rates of fertilizer for N, P, or K. It could be starter fertilizer versus no starter or strip grazing compared to continuous grazing. We want to help you find out what is best for your operation and the environment. What is the question you want to ask and try to find the answer to? Let us help you set up an on-farm trial or side-by-side comparison. #### 2022 AWARD NOMINATION INFO

We need your help identifying those in our community who are practicing resource conservation in some way! Each year the MSWCD likes to recognize those in our county who are contributing to the betterment of the environment. Examples include a farmer you purchase produce from at the Farmers' Market; a business that has installed energy-saving lighting through-out its site; a neighbor who has established a garden of native plants for pollinators; a group that has started a community garden; or a teacher who is passionate about the environment and passes that on to his/her students. Please consider nominating a deserving individual, group, or business for one of the award categories listed below. A simple nomination form is on the reverse side; please complete as much of it as possible and be sure to give us a brief explanation as to why you are submitting this nominee. Submit the form to the MSWCD by August 3, 2022. Forms can be mailed to MSWCD, 225 Underwood Street, Ste. 100, Zanesville, Ohio 43701 or scanned/emailed to doreen.maurer@muskingumswcd.org.

- Resource Conservation Award, Agricultural Division—Nominee must actively be engaged in farming (own, operate, or both). They must be actively working with the MSWCD. The farm must be located in Muskingum County. They must have demonstrated conservation practices within the last five years. The winner will receive a "Cooperator for the Year" sign, monogramed shirts or engraved tumblers, etc. (to be determined annually by the staff), and two complimentary banquet tickets. The winner will then be nominated for the Ohio Conservation Family Farm Award the following year.
- 2. **Resource Conservation Award, Non-Agricultural**—The site/project or business must be located within Muskingum County and demonstrate resource conservation. It must have a pleasing appearance, demonstrate community benefits and have an educational value. The winner will receive a plaque and two complimentary banquet tickets.
- 3. **Backyard Conservationist**—The nominee will need to fill out a form about their backyard and provide pictures for the awards committee to review. Awards are based on the benefit of the small-scale practices installed, not just on appearance. The winner will receive a \$25 gift certificate to a local garden center (Timber Run, McDonald's, etc.), a framed certificate and two complimentary banquet tickets.
- 4. Conservation Educator of the Year—Let us know about the nominee, the nominee's knowledge of conservation concepts, how the nominee promotes conservation beyond the job requirements, the use of creativity in teaching conservation, and/or how the nominee's students have applied their knowledge. The winner will receive a plaque to be displayed at the school, a gift card for educational materials, and two complimentary banquet tickets.
- 5. **Special Educational Outreach Award**—The nominee is in some way helping to educate the general public about conservation and/or agriculture or, as a business, is following good conservation measures (for example, by installing solar panels). Nominees are individuals, organizations, groups or businesses that don't fit into one of the categories above (1-4). The winners receive a plaque and two complimentary banquet tickets.
- 6. **Friends of Conservation Award**—This award was created to recognize those businesses, organizations, groups and/or individuals that contribute to the fulfillment of the MSWCD mission in some way. That could include hosting an event for free, donating funds or supplies for projects, or volunteering for a project. The winners receive a plaque and two complimentary banquet tickets.

All winners are recognized on our social media sites, website and Newsletter as well.

#### IF YOU PLANT IT, THEY WILL COME



You've probably heard the saying, "If you build it, they will come" from the movie, *The Field of Dreams*. We decided to test that theory, with our own spin on it. We have built a garden for the pollinators...so now we're waiting on them to arrive!

Late in 2021, the District, in partnership with the Muskingum County Master Gardeners, received a Neighborhood Grant from the City of Zanesville to establish an educational pollinator garden next to the parking lot at the Rural Services Building. The funds were used to purchase fence, ground fabric, and seed to establish the garden on the lot the Muskingum County Commissioners are generously letting us use as the garden site.

As I write this article, District staff and summer interns have the fence installed and they, along with several Master Gardeners, have planted over 700 plants in the garden. There are a few plants to go in yet, then mulch will be put down, and signs will be installed. The garden site features several sample gardens, including a shade garden, a wet-area garden, native grasses, a milkweed garden, and one for full-sun. Small signs will be installed that will identify each plant. A large sign will feature some common pollinating insects

that might be found in the garden, along with pictures of some of the plants in bloom.

The District would like to thank The OSU Muskingum County Master Gardeners, the City of Zanesville, the Muskingum County Commissioners and County Maintenance Department, and the Muskingum County Community Foundation.

When you are out and about, be sure to check out the newly established Rural Services Building Pollinator Garden, at 831 Shinnick Street (beside 225 Underwood Street). It is free, educational, and open to the public. We hope to see you enjoying the garden soon!
